To receive this recognition, a person must pass a 165-question examination based on information found in a training manual and through practical work experience. To retain the certification, an Ohio Certified Nursery Technician must continuously expand his or her knowledge of the green industry by attending seminars and courses. The program is sponsored by the Ohio Nursery and Landscape Association.
